A Message from Pastor Andy

"Keep Leaning"

Before I fall asleep, I tend to lie in my bed and scroll through my phone. I know, I know. It's a bad habit, but I do it anyway. I check the news. I check my email. I check for good deals on used SUVs. Eventually, I'll hear a groan from the person lying next to me- my wife. I try to ignore it. I'm in the middle of very important business!

Unfortunately, she will proceed to toss and turn as she struggles to find a comfortable lying position. Finally, she verbalizes her complaints and frustrations, and I have to put down my phone in order to give her my undivided attention. She and I have the same conversation we had the previous night.

I nod along to the same three points: Pregnancy is hard, pregnancy is unfair, and pregnancy is too long. The last point about pregnancy being too long usually dovetails into how she can't believe she still has another two months to go. How can she possibly endure another two months of *this*?

I've never been pregnant, and barring a science fiction scenario, I will never be pregnant. Still, to a degree, I can relate to my wife's sentiment about pregnancy being too long. I acknowledge and affirm the sentiment undergirding her complaint. Though she is beyond tired of dealing with the inconveniences of pregnancy, she must press on. The journey continues whether she likes it or not.

I imagine that's how dealing with the coronavirus has been for many of us. We may be sick and tired of hearing and reading about the virus, wearing masks, and missing out on beloved activities. Sadly, the virus doesn't care, and we have no choice but to accommodate its presence. The path of least resistance might be to throw a tantrum or fall into despair. With faith, there is another option.

If you feel worn down this season, I encourage you to turn toward the everlasting God who sees and knows you. Engage in the proven spiritual disciples that connect the grace of God to us. I am referring to good old fashion bible reading, prayer, and helping those in need. In doing so, I trust God will deepen your capacity to bear the burdens of the season.
