

Work somehow always bleeds into the weekends. I get it. Still, I ask and challenge you, won't you stay a while? This fall I pray that we would be more intentional about fostering the relationships with our siblings in Christ. Let's make it a prior and I promise you the God's love will fill the atmosphere every time we meet.




#### **Trunk or Treat**


#### **College Ministry**


