On a typical fall Saturday, I like to stay home and catch a Michigan State football game on television. The couch is comfortable, the snacks plentiful, and the task is mindless. Unfortunately, most of my Saturdays have been booked. On one weekend, I had to spend a good portion of the day purchasing a newto-me car. On another, I had to officiate a wedding over in Flint. Most recently, I missed out on MSU football, because my wife and I took our daughters to "Disney on Ice" at Little Caesar's Arena.

While I have less time to watch MSU football lose its games, I apparently have more time to listen to my daughters -especially the younger one- sing songs from Frozen, dress up as characters from Frozen, or to request all kinds of Frozen merchandise. I am solidly in the Frozen phase of parenting. (Send help). As a result, our little one wanted a Frozen themed birthday cake for her 3rd birthday on October 2nd. In the days leading up to it, she reminds me repeatedly, "me gonna have fwozen birthday cake." It warms my heart. As a father, how can I say refuse? The cake has been ordered.

Parents want to enrich the lives of their children, ensure they feel loved, and instill in them a sense they are special. Beyond that, some grandparents just want to spoil the kids rotten. From what I understand, that's a grandparent's job. So, if a young son or daughter wants a Frozen ¬-themed cake or has a specific birthday gift in mind, we do our absolute best to deliver. They often will remember the act of love for their whole lives. On the flipside, they will likely remember the disappointment if we fail to deliver too.

Recently, it came to my attention that the Methodist Children's Home Society needed a sponsor for its monthly Birthday Club program which seeks to celebrate the birthdays of the foster boys living on campus. Building off the relationship we already have with MCHS, the development officer hoped that we might step up to sponsor their November Birthday Club:

Birthday Club is usually done the 3rd Wednesday of every month if there is a celebrant. We send out a wishlist with gifts and food preferences for the donors to shop for and we ask that the gifts are no more that \$75-\$125 in total and wrapped for the party. Dinner needs to be a catered/ordered from a restaurant and include drinks, plates, napkins, cups, and silverware. We take care of the cake as we now work with a nonprofit organization who donates them to us! We usually budget around 20-35 people but that number is subject to change based on the number of children celebrating. We also ask that you bring decorations. Pick a theme and get creative! November will be a big one as there are 4 celebrants currently.

This is a big ask, but I know our church is equipped to take it on. I have confidence that God's people will continue to respond generously to meet the wishlist of each individual boy, the catered food, and the decorations. More than that, I have confidence, people will show up on the day of the celebration to be a source of love and light to these special boys that need it. Lastly, I believe this is just one small chapter in our commitment to be nurture, invest in, and show love for the children that God loves and has not forgotten.

I ask that you would continue to pray for MCHS, the residents, our church. When the opportunity arises, please respond generously with your donations, your time, your talents, your energy, your presence.


Remind






