Making Sense of the Bible - Fall Pastor's Class

This fall, Pastor Tonya Arnesen will lead a 7 week study based on Adam Hamilton's book, "Making Sense of the Bible." We'll explore how the Bible developed over thousands of years; and how to read, understand and interpret scripture. We'll even discuss what the Bible says (and does not say) about controversial topics – like faith and science, human sexuality, sin and evil.

This is a GREAT introductory course for anyone who has never read the Bible -- AND it's a great refresher course for anyone who wants to learn more! You'll be asked to do a bit of reading each week (not a lot, I promise) and come prepared to discuss the book and companion video presented by Adam Hamilton.
