I was torn. Initially, I thought it was a good idea to text my neighbor and invite her and her children to our next kids' event. But as a true over-thinker, doubts began to creep in: What if she thinks I'm annoying or pushy? What if I've misread all our previous interactions and she secretly hates me? I wasn't sure what to do. Should I send the text or not?

I ultimately sent the text message, because I remembered all the benefits of this event: free dinner, exercise, creative play, and a chance to make new connections or friends. This is something my neighbor and her little ones would enjoy. After I sent the text, I did not receive an immediate response which (sadly) caused me to panic. However, a few hours later, my neighbor came to church for the event, and they absolutely loved it.

At the end of this month, we have Christmas—a time when we remember and celebrate how God stepped down from eternity to be with us. All people, without exception, have been and continue to be invited to encounter the power and presence of our Lord, Jesus Christ. The benefits of such an encounter include hope, peace, joy, and love, to name just a few.

With that in mind, I wonder if you might be willing to help get the word out about Jesus' arrival and everything he offers. If you've encountered Christ and know what it's like to walk with him, would you consider inviting a friend or family member to get acquainted—or reacquainted—with Jesus, too?

Maybe that means texting a neighbor to join you on December 14th for the Children's Pageant. (This is how one of our new members began attending our church—they came for the pageant in 2024, and they've been here ever since!)

Or maybe you can bring a friend to our Longest Night service on December 20th, led by Pastor Tonya. This service acknowledges that for many, Christmas can be a time of Ioneliness, sorrow, alienation, or sadness. We make room for those feelings while surrounding one another with the compassionate love of God, experiencing healing and hope together.

And of course, you can always invite someone to our Christmas Eve services at 7pm or 10pm. Faraway relatives, out-of-town college students, and church friends we haven't seen in a while often come on Christmas Eve. Most people want to be invited. Most people want to be with others to celebrate and hear the good news of God's light coming into the world. Consider who you might invite to one of our Christmas Eve services this year.

As we prepare for Christ's arrival, let us recall what we ourselves have been invited into, let us consider who in our lives might be blessed in the same way, and let us eagerly extend the invitation.
